

Correction: Rabies surveillance in the United States during 2007

In the report “Rabies surveillance in the United States during 2007” (*J Am Vet Med Assoc* 2008;233:884–897), a database error produced an overestimation for the states of Alabama and Florida. In Table 1, the numbers for Alabama and Florida should read as follows:
