

Supplementary Figure S1—Noncontrast transverse CT images of the skull of the horse described in Figure 1 obtained at the level of both temporomandibular joints (TMJs; A) and just rostral to both incisura mandibulae (mandibular notches; B) following manual reduction of right TMJ luxation. The right mandibular condylar process (asterisk) articulates with the right temporal bone mandibular fossa, and the TMJs appear fairly symmetric. There is improved alignment of the previously identified fractures of the right mandibular condylar process (black arrow) and coronoid process (white arrow). In each image, the horse’s right side is toward the left. Both images are displayed in a bone window (window width, 4,000 HU; window level, 500 HU) with a 2-mm slice thickness.
