

Supplementary Figure S1—Representative ventral images of the sacrum (S) and the first coccygeal vertebra (Cc1) [sacrocaudal transitional vertebra] with 1 or more nutrient foramina harvested from cadavers of 38 client-owned horses that died or were euthanized for unrelated reasons between November 2019 and October 2021 and evaluated for anatomic variations and bony changes of the lumbosacroiliac region (A and B; cranial is to the top of the images). Two nutrient foramina of different size are visible (circle) on the ventral aspect of the first coccygeal vertebra, which is fused with the last sacral vertebra (A). The last sacral vertebra imaged, which is fused with the first coccygeal vertebra, shows 1 nutrient foramen (arrow) and fusion of the left transverse processes.
